**Footnotes**

PURE CLASS a bit slow to begin, settled inside chasing the pace, bid along the rail past midstretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out and pulled clear late under some urging. AMERICAS DREAMING (IRE) chased outside the winner, swung out a bit wide into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip after some urging a sixteenth out but finished well to just get the place outside foes. KAYCE ACE close up stalking the pace off the rail to the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and edged a rival for third. SCARLETT'S PLACE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, fought back outside the winner in deep stretch and was edged late for a minor award. HARD WAY TEN four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep to the stretch to loom a threat in midstretch but could not summon the necessary late kick. DAMINI stalked between foes early then outside a rival, dropped back between horses on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
